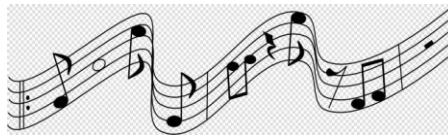
The meetings for this group are the 3rd Monday of each month @
